Our Commitments

1. Avoid establishing facilities or conducting operational activities in globally or nationally significant biodiversity areas, such as Natura 2000, UNESCO-designated areas.
2. Actively support biodiversity conservation initiatives, including the United Nations Convention on Biological Diversity and other relevant international frameworks.
3. Conduct regular biodiversity risk and impact assessments across operational sites and activities, setting goals in priority order, and implement mitigation measures to reduce ecological impact.
4. Implement green manufacturing practices to mitigate biodiversity loss at operational sites.
5. Support and promote projects that enhance ecological resilience, such as afforestation, habitat adoption, and ecosystem restoration programs, and strive to achieve the goals of No Net Deforestation and Net Positive Impact by 2050.
6. Collaborate with the supply chain to jointly reduce environmental impacts by requiring compliance with biodiversity conservation regulations, and preventing operational activities that may affect vital habitats and cause significant impacts on the natural environment.
7. Promote biodiversity awareness and understanding, enhance public awareness of ecological conservation and environmentally responsible practices, and encourage broader participation in conservation actions.
