

Biodiversity Policy

In order to mitigate the impacts and reduce the dependence of our operational activities on biodiversity, GlobalWafers commits to taking action from within its own operations, supporting the United Nations Convention on Biological Diversity and Sustainable Development Goals. We aim to collaborate with our partners throughout the supply chain, fostering awareness and engaging proactively in conservation efforts to ensure the integrity of biodiversity.

Our strategies:

- 1. Avoid the establishment of facilities or operational activities in globally or nationally significant biodiversity areas (such as Natura 2000, UNESCO, etc.).
- 2. Take proactive measures to support initiatives that uphold biodiversity, in response to conventions like the United Nations Convention on Biological Diversity.
- 3. Conduct regular biodiversity risk assessments for our operational activities, setting goals in priority order, and implementing mitigation measures to reduce ecological impact.
- 4. Collaborate with the supply chain to jointly reduce environmental impacts: requiring supply chain partners to comply with biodiversity conservation regulations, avoiding operational activities that affect vital habitats and cause significant impacts on the natural environment.
- 5. Promote understanding of biodiversity issues, enhancing public awareness of ecological conservation and environmentally friendly practices, and encouraging overall ecological conservation actions.
